Parent - Spectator Alert!

The following notice will continue to appear in this electronic newsletter until several hardheaded parents finally get the message. If you think I am talking about you, you are probably correct.

Parents and spectators must stay 20 yards away from any tournament player during the entire round. Violation of this rule will result in penalty strokes or disqualification. Parents may act as forecaddies to speed things along, or look for lost balls if there is a need, but must remain 20 yards away from all golfers. Only tournament directors or their appointees may walk the course alongside a player. Parents and spectators are required to avoid the appearance of caddying.
