



## PIKES PEAK JUNIOR GOLF - HISTORIC TIMELINE\*

- 1968- Golf professionals Dow Finsterwald, Lars Larsen, and Paul Ransom create PPJG. Broadmoor Golf Club, Colorado Springs Country Club, Patty Jewett Golf Club, and Valley Hi Golf Club were the original participation clubs. Paul Ransom, President (1968-1989), Jim Kirkley, Tournament Director (1968-1973)
- 1969- Eisenhower Golf Club joins PPJG
- 1970- Pueblo Country Club and Pueblo City Park (now Elmwood) join PPJG
- 1971- Woodmoor Country Club joins PPJG
- 1973- Country Club of Colorado and Gleneagle Golf Club join PPJG. First Junior Championship - The Un-Cola Junior Championship at Gleneagle sponsored by Springs Bottling Company (1973-1987)
- 1974- Duke Goggin, Tournament Director
- 1975- Lee Hall, Tournament Director (1975-present)
- 1980- "Niners" program begins; Nine-hole tournaments for boys and girls ages 10-12
- 1988- KRDO becomes title sponsor for Junior Championship. Harry Hoth, KRDO owner helps establish the Pikes Peak Junior Scholarship program with the help of area PGA professionals.
- 1990- Jim Lipp, President (1990-1994), Bill Majure, Scholarship Coordinator (1990 - 1999)
- 1994- Ann Finke, President (1995 - 2002)
- 2000- Mike Northern, Scholarship Coordinator (2000 - present)
- 2003- Greg Jones, President (2003 - present)
